

RULES AND REGULATIONS – Breast Cancer Charity Neon Run 2019

1. No pets or any form of wheel-run objects of transport e.g. inline skates, prams, push cars, shoes with built-in or attached rollers are allowed on the course other than official race and medical vehicles.
2. It is compulsory for the participants to display their race number at all times during the race. Failure to comply will result in the participants' disqualification from the race.
3. Participants must run on the designated path for the entire race. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
4. All participants are encouraged to wear the Breast Cancer Charity Neon Run 2019 event t-shirt during the race.
5. Race entry is non-transferable. Those who are found running with an unauthorized race number from The Organizer will be disqualified.
6. Participants must wear their allocated bib number at all times during the race. Runners without the allocated bib number will not be allowed to take part in the race. Participants are advised to wear the official race apparel.
7. Participants hereby release, waive, discharge, and relinquishes any action or causes of action for personal injury, property damage, or wrongful death which may occur during the event(s) or any pursuit incidental thereto. Participants further agree that under no circumstances will they prosecute or present any claim against the Event Organiser, or any member, legal entity or person associated with the Event Organiser (together, the “Event Organiser’s vendors”) for any causes of action, personal injury, property damage, or death, whether the same shall arise by the negligence or non-intentional conduct of any of the Event Organiser during the event(s) or any pursuit incidental thereto.
8. Participants are required to be punctual. Late comers are not allowed to join the race unless valid reason stated.
9. Participants are required to finish the race route, failure to do so will result in disqualification or will not receive any goodies bag.
10. Participants who own vehicles are required to make sure their vehicles would not cause any traffic problem.
11. Participants are informed that to throw the rubbish into dustbin. Anyone violating this rule of conduct shall be disqualified from the event and will be asked to leave the course.
